What homework will my child get?

Maths - children will be set weekly homework on www.maths.co.uk

They will also have access to TTRockStars to secure timetables knowledge.

Reading - children are expected to read every day for at least 10 minutes. They will bring home a colour banded book to read and a book for pleasure.

SPAG - homework will be set every two weeks on www.SPAG.com

Spellings - children will be sent home weekly spellings on a Monday to learn for a quiz on the following Friday.

Self-quizzing – children will be encouraged to self-quiz using the knowledge organisers for Science and Humanities topics.

What other key information do I need to know?

PE days are on a Tuesday so please ensure your child has the expected kit and remove any jewellery.

Book changing days are on a Monday so please send books and book bags in on this day only.

School doors open at 8.25am so please ensure that the children are in early as this will ensure a calm, relaxed start of the day.

Secure times tables knowledge is key for future success in Maths. Year 4 children will be preparing to take the Statutory Times Tables Check in the summer term. This on-screen tool (containing 25 questions) checks their ability to fluently recall times tables up to 12x12.

There is no 'pass mark' but higher scores indicate strong times tables knowledge. This check will allow us to identify pupils who need additional support in mastering their times tables in Upper Key Stage 2.
