

Vocabulary - Types of materials

Man-made- things are created by people.

Natural- things that exist in nature and are not made by people.

1	Wood	The material which forms the trunks and branches of trees.
2	Brick	Rectangular blocks of baked clay used for building walls, which are usually red or brown.
3	Fabric	Cloth or other material produced by weaving together cotton, wool or other threads.
4	Foil	Sheets of metal as thin as paper.
5	Glass	A hard transparent material.
6	Metal	A hard material such as iron, steel, gold, or lead.
7	Plastic	A material which is light in weight and does not break easily.
8	Elastic	A rubber material that stretches when you pull it and returns to its original size and shape when you let it go.
9	Rock	The hard material which the Earth is made of.

10	Bendy	An object that bends easily into a curved shape
11	Shiny	Things are bright and reflect light
12	Smooth	No roughness, lumps, or holes
13	Soft	Not rough or hard
14	Stiff	Firm or does not bend easily
15	Stretchy	Slightly elastic
16	Rough	Uneven and not smooth
17	Dull	A colour or light that is not bright

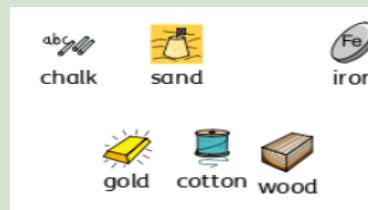
