1	Deciduous	A tree that loses its leaves in Autumn and grows new ones in Spring.
2	Evergreen	A plant or tree that keeps its leaves all year.
3	Roots	They lie below the surface of the soil and anchor the plant to the ground.
4	Leaves	They are usually green and flat and grow from the stem.
5	Stem trunk (tree)	The part above ground which provides support for leaves. The trunk of a tree supports the crown and gives the tree its shape.
6	Flowers	The part of a plant that makes new seeds, often made of petals and may have a nice scent (smell).
7	Twig	A thin, woody shoot growing from a branch
8	branches	A part of the tree that grows out from the trunk.
9	Crown	The leaves and branches at the top of a tree

- Mosses are small plants that grow in damp places. and grow together in large, thick mats.



BUSHES AND SHRUBS

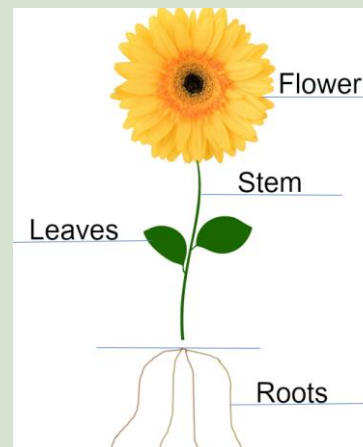
- Bushes and shrubs are quite short plants that have lots of branches,
