Vocabulary

1	Physical feature	Physical features are things that you can see all around you. Physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural.
2	Human Feature	Human features are things that you can see all around you. Human features like houses, churches and roads have been built by humans.
3	OS Map	Ordnance Survey is Britain's mapping agency. OS create up to date and accurate maps depicting the landscape's human and physical features.
4	Aerial Map	Aerial photos taken for the purpose of using it as a map.
5	Topography	Topography is the study of the forms and features of land surfaces.
6	Contour Lines	A line on a map joining points of equal height above or below sea level.
7	Relief	Relief refers to the way the landscape changes in height.
8	Census	A census is a survey that records the population of an area, as well as certain information about that population.
9	Population	All the inhabitants of a particular place.
10	Fieldwork	Practical work conducted by a researcher in the natural environment, rather than in a laboratory or office.
