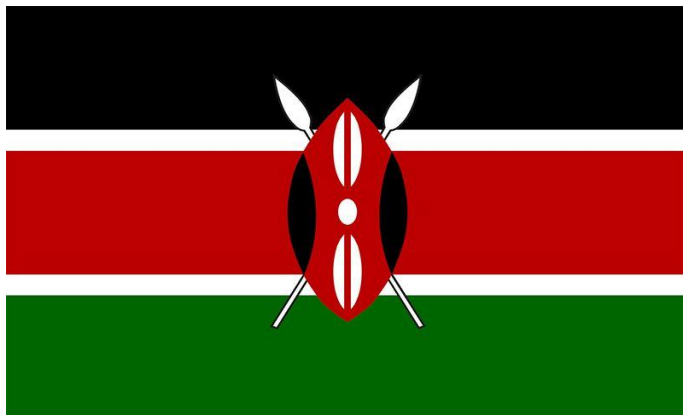


How does the UK compare to Kenya?

Climate	Kenya is on the equator which means it is a hot country. It stays hot all year round. Instead of hot and cold seasons, they have wet and dry seasons.
Size	Kenya is twice the size of the UK.
Physical features	A lot of Kenya is covered by African savanna. We do not have a savanna in the UK.
Cities	Kenya has big cities with buildings and roads just like in the UK.
Villages	In some villages in Kenya, the houses are made from mud and thatch. In villages in the UK, houses are made from brick or stone.

6	Savanna	A tropical grassland in Africa.
7	Valley	A low area of land between hills or mountains, typically with a river or stream flowing through it.
8	City	A place where many people live which usually has lots of buildings and roads.
9	Countryside	The land and scenery of a rural area.
10	Farming	A piece of land used to grow crops and/or raise animals for produce.
