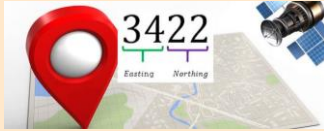


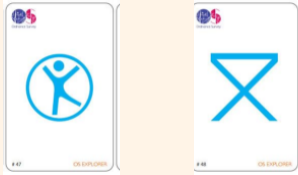
Parts of an OS map

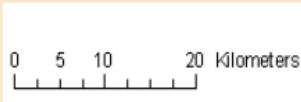
A four figure grid reference shows you the location of a specific place on your map. You need to read eastings and northings.

Maps use OS symbols to label real-life features and make maps clearer.

A map scale helps us understand the distance between places.

Vocabulary

1	OS Map	This tells you the location of places. It uses symbols and key to help make it easier to understand.
2	Sketch Map	A roughly drawn map that only shows the basic details.
3	Proposal	An idea that is put forward.
4	Employment	The state of having paid work.
5	Tourist	Someone who goes somewhere for personal enjoyment.
6	Economy	How a local area makes money.
7	Pollution	The presence in the environment of a substance which is harmful.
8	Habitats	The natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other organism.
9	Green Spaces	An area of grass, trees, or other vegetation in an otherwise urban environment.
10	Protest	When you feel really strongly against something and you make a stand against it.

Reasons for the Proposal

1. Around 2,000 jobs will be created.
