Trip to British Ironworks Centre, Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2026



Beech (Y4) and Cedar (Y5) are going to the British Ironwork Centre, Oswestry on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2026.

The site is the UK's most epic open-air sculpture park; home to the largest collection of decorative metalwork, inspiring sculptures and incredible art from around the world.

Whilst there, the children will follow trails around the site seeing projects such as the Knife Angel, Deforestation Sculpture and Gorilla Apocalypse.

We will be leaving school by coach at approximately 8:30 am (so please ensure all children are in at 8:00 am for Breakfast Club). We will be back at school for approximately 3:30pm and will keep parents updated on their arrival.

All children will require a packed lunch, and a water bottle. If your child is Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided from school, but children will still need their water bottle.

Please ensure that all children are wearing their full school uniform for this trip. Please ensure that your child also has a hat and sunscreen applied (if the weather looks hot) and/or a coat (if it looks like it may rain)



British Ironworks are also asking if every child could bring an old spoon / milk bottle tops / old toothbrushes / empty crisp packets in order to use them in an upcoming recycling project.
