On Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2023, Cedar (Y5) & Sycamore (Y6) class have been invited us to the 'Forces in STEM' event at RAF Cosford.

Forces in STEM is a large STEM event that brings together the armed forces, leading aerospace companies and local businesses. There will be over 30 drop-in hands-on STEM activities for students to participate in.

The event is delivered in partnership with the Royal Air Force Youth STEM team, this event features the very best of the Midlands region, showcasing the fantastic work carried out by the companies and institutions that are innovating, researching and manufacturing across the STEM spectrum .

If you would like your child to attend, the cost of this trip will be £10.00, which is payable through Parent Pay under the payment item heading 'RAF Cosford STEM Day 24 09 25'. **Full payment is required by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2025 for your child to be able to attend.**

Please ensure children are in school for **8:00am**, as we will be leaving shortly after this time in order to arrive at the start of the event.

The event finishes at 2.30pm and we hope to be back to school by approx. 3.45pm but will keep parents updated via text on the day.

All children will require full school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle with them, unless they are Free School Meals, in which case the school will provide one for them. If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch from home, please let the office know.
